

# Broodmare Incentive Program Mare Contract

I, \_\_\_\_\_ ( hereafter the **Mare Owner**) agree to foal out the mare \_\_\_\_\_ in British Columbia and either race the horse in BC, or sell it privately or through a sale conducted by the Canadian Thoroughbred Horse Society (BC Division) in return for receiving \$1,000 directly from the **Broodmare Incentive Program**. Further, another \$500 will be paid on behalf of the **Mare Owner** to the **Owner** of the stallion the above named mare was bred to upon a **Live Foal Report** being received at the CTHS (BC Division) offices as a result of that breeding.

The \$1,000 will be paid to the **Mare Owner** in two instalments:

1. The first payment of \$500 will be made upon the CTHS office receiving a signed copy of a **Breeding Contract** to a stallion registered for the **Broodmare Incentive Fund** and a signed **Letter of Commitment** from the **Mare Owner** to foal out in British Columbia and either race the horse in BC, or sell it privately or through a sale conducted by the Canadian Thoroughbred Horse Society (BC Division).
2. A second payment of \$500 will be made to the **Mare Owner** when a **Licensed Veterinarian** certifies the mare as being in foal.

A third payment of \$500 will be made to the **Stallion Owner** when the **Live Foal Report** is received at the Canadian Thoroughbred Society Offices (BC Division). As a condition of the **Broodmare Incentive Program**, the **Stallion Owner** is required to provide a discount of \$500 dollars off the advertised stud fee to the above named **Mare Owner**; therefore, this payment is for the sole benefit of the **Mare Owner**, and is in no way in lieu of, or compensation for, the discount the **Stallion Owner** is required to provide in order to qualify for the **Broodmare Incentive Program**.

Mares that are the property of stallion owners are not eligible to be bred under the Program to the stallions he or she owns, regardless of whether the stallion is owned outright, leased, or held through syndication. However, such mares are eligible to be bred to other stallions if both mare and stallion are otherwise eligible under the Program.
